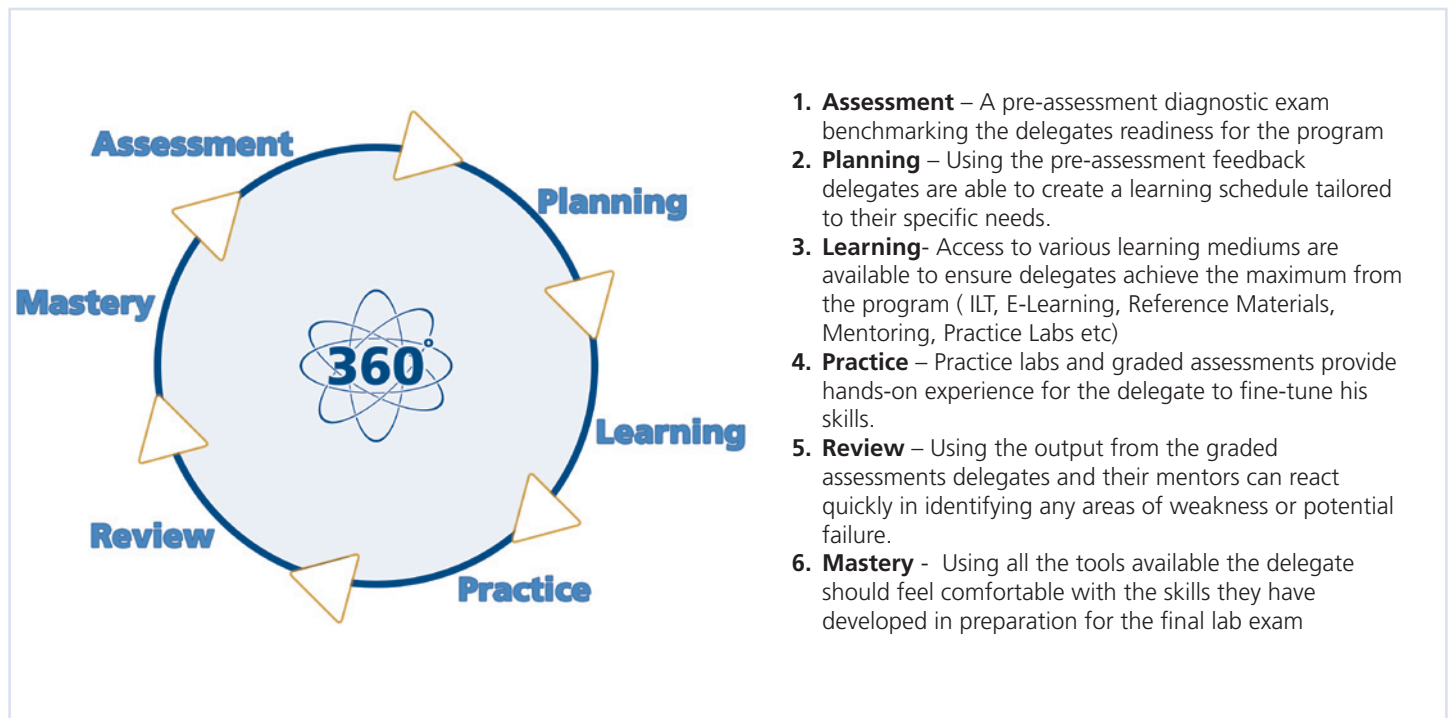

Curriculum Developed with a Blended Learning Methodology



The Cisco 360 Concept is a six-stage pathway to success and utilizes a collaborative methodology, combining learning modules, and formative assessments to give learners the ability to customize their training and keep them informed of their absorption of the material as they progress through the various stages of the curriculum.

The new Cisco 360 Learning Program for CCIE Routing and Switching delivers a complete, end-to-end learning environment driven by a Learning Management System (LMS) that offers unique tracking and assessment capabilities. The program includes pre-assessments to identify knowledge gaps, training modules to fill those gaps, lab scenarios to help develop hands-on skills, and practice exams to prepare for the actual certification exams.



What does the program consist of ?

The program consists of four core elements, Self-paced E-Learning, two Instructor Led Advanced Workshops, and Mentoring/Practice Labs.

Whilst it is recommended that all components of the program are followed, so that delegates can experience the full benefits of this unique program it is recognized that each individuals needs are different and therefore the core elements can be broken down further and purchased as individual components designed to meet the specific individuals needs.

Recommended Prerequisites

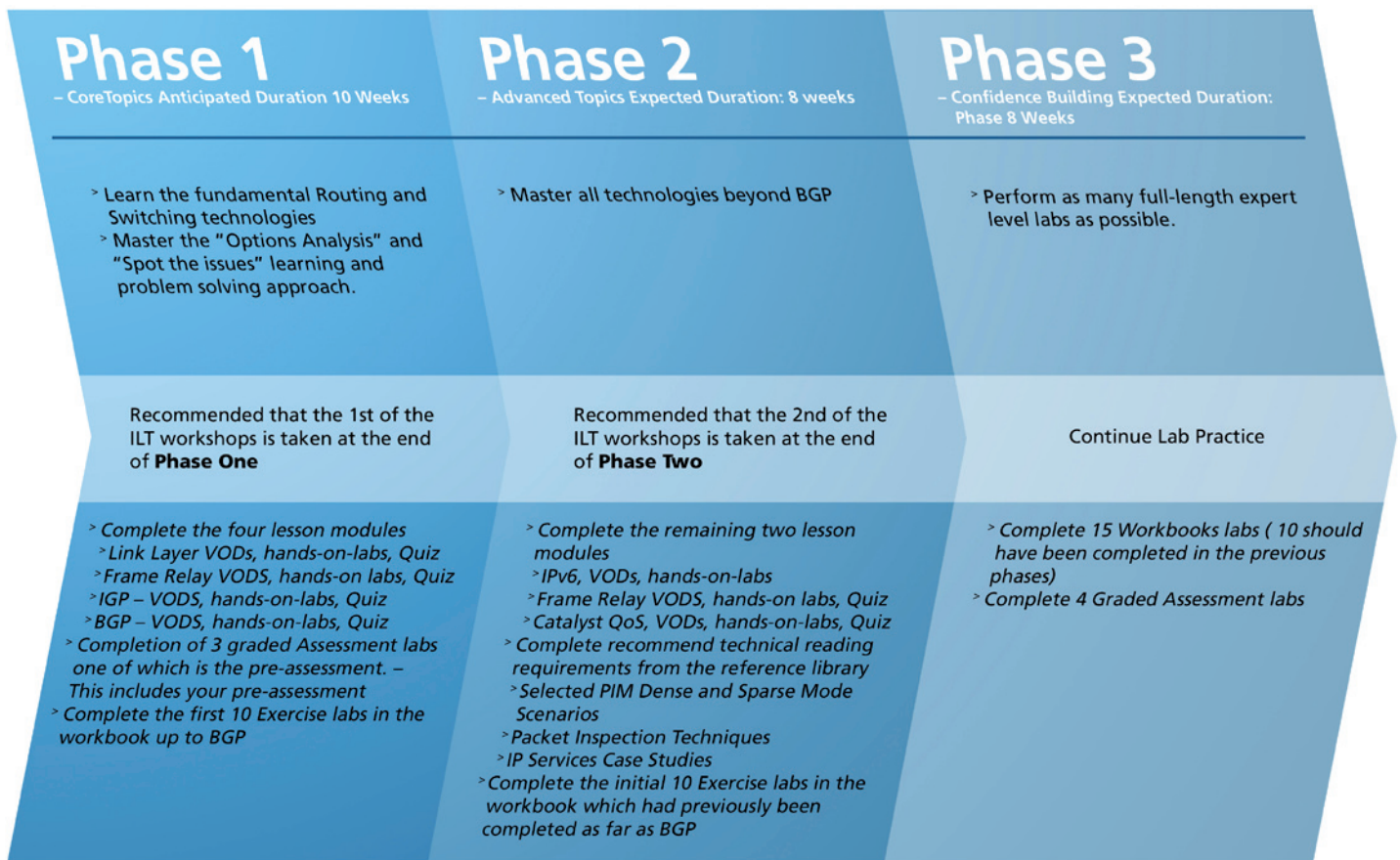
All participants are expected to have attained a CCNP in Routing and Switching and have between 3 and 5 years Routing and Switching experience. The CCIE written exam should also have been attained before starting this program. Global Knowledge offers a CCIE Theory course for those delegates who have yet to pass this exam.

Exam Information

The current version of the CCIE R&S exam is v4.0. This new exam has less emphasis on networking concepts and equipment operation, as these should be understood at professional level and is more focused on the troubleshooting aspects that a CCIE would realistically expect to encounter in a production environment. A number of new topics have been introduced and more detail can be found in [Cisco's Exam Blueprint](#). To support the new version the lab equipment has been upgraded with IOS 12.4(T) on the Routers and IOS 12.2 Advanced IP Services on the Switches. Lab exams can only be scheduled direct with Cisco .

Program Phasing



A delegate's progression through this program is managed via Cisco's Learning Management System which provides delegates with a management tool that is easily accessible and available 24 x 7. The Cisco LMS provides:

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Summary of Individual Program Components

Self-Paced eLearning Components

1. Pre-assessment – CIEPREASSES - \$285

This is a 4-hour diagnostic pre-assessment lab which is designed to measure the delegate's current competency. A score report is provided and this helps both the delegate and the selected learning provider choose the appropriate curriculum and learning components most suitable for the delegate's needs. This curriculum planning is done with one of our authorized CCIE 360 Instructors thus ensuring that the program recommendation comes from individuals who fully understand the possibilities of each component.

2. Exercise Workbook – CIERSWB - \$595

The CCIE R&S workbook contains 30 lab scenarios to help students practice and apply their learning on network equipment. Please note that the purchase of this component does not include the lab rental and it is anticipated that students can use their own practice lab, or that of their employer. Alternatively, Global Knowledge can also provide lab for rent.

4. Assessment Labs - \$395 - CIERSASSESS- 1 to CIERSASSESS-11

Cisco 360 Learning Program for CCIE R&S offers a suite of 11 nine-hour assessment labs that can be taken independently or as part of an instructor-led workshop. Each assessment tests the student's knowledge of concepts and technologies and tracks progress against learning goals and other students. A built-in mentoring guide provides detailed feedback, corrections and best practices for configurations. Assessments vary in degree of difficulty and are designed to be used at various stages of the learning process.

Instructor Led Workshops

1. CIERS Advanced Workshop 1 - CIERS1 - \$3,995

Led by an experienced CCIE 360 instructor and the first of two 5-day hands-on courses, this course is designed for delegates who require an in-depth understanding of frame relay, link layer, BGP, IGP, etc. This workshop is approximately 60% lecture and 40% hands-on and includes two eight-hour assessment labs, which are graded and returned with mentor feedback. Delegates should be prepared for a week of 12 hour days if they are to get the most from this course. Cisco will provide the courseware in electronic format and delegates must bring their own laptops with them to the course.

2. CIERS Advanced Workshop 2 - CIERS2 - \$4,500

Our second 5-day hands-on course is designed for delegates who wish to hone their skills and master advanced configuration and troubleshooting. This workshop is approximately 20% lecture and 80% hands-on labs and includes five eight hour assessment labs which are graded and returned with mentor feedback. It is then anticipated that delegates will work collaboratively with other students on the course and their instructor to review the feedback. Delegates should be prepared for 12 hour days and must bring their own laptops to the session as Cisco will provide the courseware in an electronic format.

Supplementary Support

Practice Labs

Access to practice labs is vital for delegates preparing to take their CCIE Lab exam and whilst some delegates may have access to either their own or their companies labs, many delegates do not.

Global Knowledge is able to provide rack rental for those students involved in the CCIE 360 program. Each lab session is 5.5 hours in duration and can be scheduled on-line at the delegate's convenience. The minimum number of sessions a delegate can purchase is 10

- » 10-24 Sessions = \$36
- » 25-49 Sessions = \$32
- » 50+ Sessions = \$30

Mentoring

Whilst mentor guides are available to those students who have purchased the E-Learning component of the program it does not totally replace the benefits of a 1: 1 relationship with an experienced and authorized CCIE 360 Mentor/Trainer. Delegates can elect to purchase additional mentoring as detailed below.

» Curriculum Planning (1:1) (30min -1hour)

Mentor recommendations of a personalized training plan based on student self assessment and feedback from the performance based pre-assessment (**PREASSES - \$285**)

» Assessment Consultation (small group)(1-2 hours)

Mentor and coaching of strategies in approaching various 360 assessments, what is covered in assessment and where learning materials can be found for assessment preparation. Typically done in a Pre- assessment review and a follow-up Post assessment review

» Chalk Talk Sessions (groups 5-25)

Informal unstructured topic based discussions, with examples and white boarding to create 2 way discussions around technical networking configuration issues.
